A Statement From the Author, as of 1986, Concerning the Book, God's Time-Records in Ancient Sediments

Although many kinds of science books rapidly become out-of-date, this one was consciously designed so as to retain its accuracy much longer than most. Throughout the writing process I studiously avoided concepts and evidences that had not been thoroughly reinvestigated, and concerning which only sparse documentation existed. Ever since the publication of the book I have continued to survey current geologic literature dealing with the topics covered, and have found no developments which would appreciably alter any of the chapters of this work.

The most significant adjustment that should now be made is that a new series of shallow drillings across the top of the Great Bahama Bank has shown that the Bank was formerly a coral atoll and that corals contributed to its growth much more than was formerly thought. This is related to pages 113-123 of the book, but of course does not contradict the main mass of data cited regarding the origin of the Bank.
